# Registration

The National Federation will select players, coaches and officials submit complete application form will to idc@hokejbal.cz.

NOTE e-mail contacts for all persons are important. Each person will be later asked to fill in the e-questionnaire with additional information.

#### **Application deadline**

• Entry reservation: till 30. 11. 2021

• Final reservation: till 27, 02, 2022

 ZOOM meeting of participants will be organized after summarizing all applications.

• In case of unused capacity, vacant places will be offered to substitutes on list of particular federations.





#### INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT CAMP

#### Age category:

- Players born in years 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007 (the player must be 15 years of age and older as of the start date of the event)
- The recommended level of players should be at the level of a wider national team selection with experience in ball hockey of at least 2 years
- Communication level of English required
- For the year 2023, the camp is also planned for the category of girls

#### **Camp schedule:**

- Four-phase training under the guidance of IDC trainers and lecturers (2x daily fitness training, 2x daily training on the pitch)
- Special training of goalkeepers under the guidance of a specialist Bc. Ondřej Almaši







#### INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT CAMP

#### Meals and accommodation:

- Meals provided by RT event in the format of breakfast, lunch, dinner, 2x snacks
- Special diet (gluten, vegetarians) must be announced in advance before the event
- Accommodation provided in the immediate vicinity of the hockey stadium
- Accommodation costs are covered by ČMSHb from the evening of July 24, 2022 to lunch on July 31, 2022

#### **Material arrangement:**

- Registered players will receive a list of equipment for completing the camp
- Each participant will receive a commemorative T-shirt for the event
- Players use only federation, club or ISBHF clothing





#### INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT CAMP

#### **Transport:**

- Transport costs are paid by the participant of the event
- CBHF will provide transport from the airport to the venue and back to the airport
- CBHF does not cover other costs associated with transport or earlier arrival
- We recommend coordinating the arrival of the group across the federation







#### INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT CAMP

#### Our goals with the players:

- Cooperation and building player relations between federations and states
- Exchange of experience and information between players coaches, coaches coaches, players players
- Development of skills and cooperation of pairs, triplets
- Dealing with situations under pressure (space and time constraints)
- Development of speed elements needed for the modern concept of ball hockey

#### **Objectives of the IDC:**

- Cooperation of federations at the international level
- Training of coaches across federations
- Communication of officials and players off the field (EN level communication)
- Divided leadership of coaches from different countries
- Building relationships and ties between players, coaches and federations

#### **INFORMATION FOR THE FEDERATIONS**

#### "Zero year" organization = 2022:

- "Zero year" will be connected to the national Camp of talented youth (CTM) U16 and U18 an international level will be added to this platform
- CBHF will cover the costs of: accommodation, meals, snacks and drinking regime of 5 people of the federation (country) for the duration of the camp, basic clothing from the event and local transport to/from Česká Třebová (applies to players with plane transport)
- Countries Slovakia, Great Britain, USA, Canada, Switzerland, Poland, Germany, Finland will have the opportunity to send 2 players to the field, one goalkeeper (aged 15-18), one coach and one federation official (5 positions for the federation)
- English speaking coordinators provided by CBHF will be present on the spot
- In the first half of the event, players participate in the camp with players from the Czech Republic in the second half of the camp, coaches from other countries join the training unit leadership (Explanation = in the first half of the camp, coaches from other countries join TU as assistants, in the second they also lead them)
- The participation of coaches will be recognized as so far undefined ISBHF Level of Education





#### **INFORMATION FOR THE FEDERATIONS**

#### **Organization of the "first year" = 2023:**

- Based on positive experience, it is possible to organize the camp separately in the Czech Republic under the same economic conditions - players outside the Czech Republic pay for transport (local costs are for CBHF), players from the Czech Republic pay a contribution to the event
- For players from the Czech Republic, this is a selection event
- Number structure = 45 field players and 10 goalkeepers the missing number above the limit for the federation can be completed by other states interested in the event
- Coaches always 2 per federation
- The first two days of the camp are led by CBHF lecturers in the following days the coaches take turns in leading TU on the given topic
- The first days of the camp are players divided into groups according to the federation, then they are mixed without distinction of the federation
- TU 2 divided TU in the morning (fitness and field), in the afternoon joint TU plus EN program
- English speaking coordinators provided by CBHF on the spot
- Possibility of girls' registration
